## Register

**September 13:** In-person registration deadline. Online voter registration is available through September 23, 2023.

## Voting

Early voting is available to all voters. In order to vote absentee, you must meet one or more of the criteria outlined in the application.

**September 30 – October 7:** Early voting available from 8:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Early voting is not available on Sunday, October 1.

**October 10, 4:30 p.m.:** Deadline to request to receive absentee ballot by mail.

**October 13:** Deadline for absentee ballots to be received.

**October 14, 2023:** Election Day.

## ID Requirements

Louisiana requires a valid photo ID in order to cast a ballot. Any generally recognized picture ID card that contains the name and signature of the applicant is acceptable. If the applicant does not have one of these forms of ID, they can complete and sign an affidavit.

## Polling Place Details

Polling places are open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
