Register

October 17: Voter registration deadline.

Voting

Early voting and vote-by-mail are available to all voters.

October 28 – November 5: Early voting available.

October 31: Deadline to request to receive a vote-by-mail ballot by mail.

November 7: Election Day; deadline of 8:00 p.m. to return vote-by-mail ballot in-person, and deadline to postmark mailed vote-by-mail ballots.

ID Requirements

New Jersey does not require an ID to vote in an election. If voting by mail, providing an accurate signature on a vote-by-mail ballot is essential to avoid a ballot cure request.

Polling Place Details

Polling places are open from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
