#### Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017 (TCIA)

- Created the 20% Small Business Deduction for pass-through businesses that expires in 2025.
- Cut the corporate tax rate permanently
- Set the estate tax exemption at \$11.2 million for individuals and \$22.4 million for married couples

- Making the 20% Small Business Deduction permanent.1
- Keeping 21% corporate tax rate.3
