DRIVING

Navigating D.C. can be difficult with the numerous roundabouts, one-way streets, herds of pedestrians, and limited parking. If you decide to drive into the city, there are free parking spaces available along the National Mall on Madison and Jefferson Drives in front of the Smithsonian Museums. However, these parking spots fill quickly and typically are restricted to two hours. One notable parking garage is Union Station. For parking details contact **Union Station**.
