Votes by your state legislators on key small business issues are listed here. Although this Voting Record does not reflect all elements considered by a lawmaker when voting, nor does it represent a complete profile of a legislator, it can be a guide in evaluating your legislator's attitudes toward small business. Please thank those legislators who supported small business.

BOTH CHAMBERS

1. Regulatory Relief (2023 - HB 264): Provides more authority to the General Assembly to push back against overly burdensome administrative regulations.

A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed the Senate 37-0. Passed the House 97-0. Became Law without the signature of the governor. Overturned by Kentucky Supreme Court.

2. Income Taxation (2023 - HB 1): Lowers the Kentucky personal income tax rates for individuals, LLCs, and S Corporations to 4.5% for the 2023 tax year. This legislation further reduces the Kentucky personal tax rate to 4% for the 2024 tax year. **A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 30-5. Passed the House 79-19. Signed by the governor.

3. Unemployment Insurance Benefits (2023 - HB 146): Overhauls the State unemployment insurance benefits system to focus on reemployment. It authorizes prospective employers to report employees who fail to attend scheduled interviews and decline job offers. **A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 36-0. Passed the House 94-0. Signed by the governor.

4. Administrative Regulations (2024 - SB 65): Renews efforts to block administrative regulations that do not comply with legislative intent. Designed to pass review by the Kentucky Supreme Court. **A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 31-6. Passed the House 77-20. Vetoed by the governor. Veto overridden by the legislature.

5. Fiscal Matters (2024 - HB 8): Requires the Kentucky Department of Revenue to publish their administrative writings, including final rulings, manuals and training procedures, and presentations, among other things. **A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 34-0. Passed the House 87-9. Line items

Vetoed by the governor. Vetoes were overridden by the legislature.

6. Broadband Development (2024 - HB 267): Creates an administrative authority to allow receipt and management of federal funds for broadband expansion to underserved areas. **A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 37-1. Passed the House 92-1. Signed by the governor.

7. Career & Technical Training (2024 - HB 499): Allows for collaboration between local school districts and technical training programs to address the workforce shortage in the state. **A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 37-1. Passed the House 95-0. Signed by the governor.
