It WHAT IS IT? also measures U.S. businesses every 5 years with the economic census. > The Economic Census is the most comprehensive measure of the U.S. economy. > The Economic Census was mailed in January 2023, covering over 4 million business locations. Companies were requested to report their 2022 year-end numbers. Although the March 15th due date has passed, it's still not too late to respond.
