

THE 2022 ECONOMIC CENSUS

WHAT IS IT?

- The U.S. Census Bureau measures the nation's population once every 10 years. It also measures U.S. businesses every 5 years with the economic census.
- The Economic Census is the most comprehensive measure of the U.S. economy.
- The Economic Census was mailed in January 2023, covering over 4 million business locations. Companies were requested to report their 2022 year-end numbers.

IT'S NOT TOO LATE TO RESPOND

- Although the March 15th due date has passed, it's still not too late to respond.
- Responses are submitted online-only through our respondent portal at portal.census.gov
- A good estimate is acceptable if book figures are not available for specific items.

YOUR RESPONSE MAKES A DIFFERENCE

- The more responses we receive, the more accurate and comprehensive our data becomes.
- Data accuracy ensures that businesses, industries, and governments have the best information available to help them make decisions.
- All data from the Economic Census is free and available online.

IT'S LEGITIMATE AND SAFE

- The Census Bureau is required by law under Title 13, U.S. Code to keep your information safe and private. Every employee is sworn for life to keep your information protected.
- Response to the Economic Census is also required by law under Title 13.
