



Background:

Franchise tax code changes taking effect in 2024 relieve small businesses making \$2.47 million or less from filing or paying a franchise tax – but Texans deserve more.

Prop 4 secures \$18 billion in tax cuts, providing meaningful tax relief measures for small businesses in Texas.

01

Increase the homestead tax exemption from \$40,000 to \$100,000.

02

Enact \$12 billion in tax compression, with the state set to buy down ISD taxes on residential and commercial property owners.

03

Limit increases on non-residential properties' taxable value to 20 percent, which applies to commercial and non-residential properties under \$5 million in value.

04

Provide greater transparency by adding three positions to each county appraisal district's board of directors.

For the #TexasTaxCut to take effect, voters must approve Prop 4 on November 7.
