

VOTING RECORD YOUR LEGISLATORS' VOTING RECORD ON SMALL BUSINESS ISSUES | 2024 EDITION

Votes by your state legislators on key small business issues are listed here. Although this Voting Record does not reflect all elements considered by a lawmaker when voting, nor does it represent a complete profile of a legislator, it can be a guide in evaluating your legislator's attitudes toward small business. Please thank those legislators who supported small business.

BOTH CHAMBERS

- 1. Childcare Payroll Tax (2023 H.217): Override of gubernatorial veto on legislation enacting a new 0.44% payroll tax on employers to fund childcare. A "NO" vote supports the NFIB position. The Senate overrode the governor's veto 23-8. The House overrode the governor's veto 116-31.
- 2. Expansion of the Bottle Deposit Law (2023 - H.158): Expands the 5-cent bottle deposit paid by consumers to other containers beyond beer and soda containers. A "NO" vote supports the **NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 19-11. Passed the House 115-29. Vetoed by the governor.
- 3. Veto of the Clean Heat Standard (2023 S.5): A vote to override the Governor's veto of legislation to establish the Clean Heat Standard (CHS) estimated to put an additional cost of at least 70 cents per gallon on heating oil, kerosene, and propane. A "NO" vote **supports the NFIB position.** The Senate overrode the governor's veto 20-10. The House overrode the governor's veto 107-42-1.
- 4. Collective Bargaining Rights (2023 S.102): Expands labor union's ability to form new bargaining units without a full election and prohibits employers from holding mandatory worker meetings to discuss topics like the impact of unionization or the effects of labor policies on the business. A "NO" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed the Senate 23-7. Carried over to the 2024 legislative session. Passed the House 115-26. The governor allowed the legislation to become law without his signature.

- **5. Veto of the Data Privacy Business Mandates** (2024 - H.121): Override of gubernatorial veto on legislation seeking to allow for a private right of action that could result in increased lawsuits for small businesses. A "NO" vote supports the NFIB **position.** The House overrode the governor's veto 128-17, but the Senate sustained the governor's veto 14-15.
- 6. Collective Bargaining Amendment to Vermont's **Constitution (2024 - P.R.3):** First step in the process to amend the Vermont Constitution to make it a right to join a union and collectively bargain for wages, hours, and working conditions while prohibiting any future laws that interfere with those efforts. A "NO" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed the Senate 29-0. Passed the House 129-8.
