




Generally speaking, do you think things in the nation are generally headed in the right direction, or are they off on the wrong track?




Generally speaking, would you rate the <u>overall business climate</u> in the country today as excellent, good, fair or poor?




How concerned are you about the size and growth of the federal deficit?




Which of the following <u>economic problems</u> should be Washington's highest priority? Should it be:






How concerned are you about the <u>Federal Reserve Bank</u> raising interest rates?




How concerned are you about your ability to <u>access credit</u> for your small business?








From this same list, which of these <u>taxes</u> would you LEAST OBJECT to being increased?




Increase the top tax rate for <u>long-term capital gains</u> from 23.8 to 28 percent.




<u>Internet</u> purchases should be subject to state and local sales taxes.






Employees should have the right to use their work email account for union organizing activities.




How concerned are you about government abuse in the taking of private property for public purposes, the so-called <u>eminent domain</u> issue?




Government should further restrict the ability of workers to be classified as <u>independent contractors</u>.




In addressing the country's <u>health insurance</u> problem, is it more important for federal lawmakers to control the cost of health insurance, or to expand coverage to those uninsured?




All employers should be required to offer <u>health insurance</u> to all their full-time employees and pay 60 percent of the premium.




All Americans should be required to have <u>health insurance</u>, whether it is employer provided or individually purchased.






Congress should increase federal <u>personal income taxes</u> to subsidize the purchase of health insurance for those who cannot afford it.




In general, the United States benefits from <u>free trade agreements</u> with other countries.




Break up businesses into smaller companies if those businesses are determined to be too big to fail, that is, a firm is so big or so important to the economy that the government cannot let it go bankrupt.






Implement measures to curb global warming even when there is a significant adverse economic effect.




Increase <u>taxes on gasoline</u>, diesel and other vehicle fuels to finance the development of non-polluting sources of energy like solar or wind power.




Increase the age to collect <u>Social Security</u> retirement benefits.




Increase FICA taxes to pay for Social Security and disability benefits.




Reduce future Social Security benefits for relatively wealthy retirees.




Remove the so-called wage base and pay <u>FICA taxes</u> on all earned income.




Let current illegal immigrants remain and eventually become citizens.




Let current <u>illegal immigrants</u> remain, but they must learn English, work, pay a fine, and wait their turns to become citizens.




Deport current illegal immigrants when identified.




Allow states to enforce federal immigration laws.
